RULES OF ENTRY:

1. Competition is open to all residents of the Parishes of Ampport, Monxton, Grateley & Quarley
2. Children's classes are open to the relevant age groups, must be their own work and comply with other rules pertaining to that class, although class 18 can be made from purchased vegetables
3. All entries in Sections A, B and C must be grown by the exhibitor (with the exception of class 14); entries in other classes must be produced entirely by the exhibitor
4. Potted plants must have been in the exhibitor's possession for at least 6 months prior to the show
5. Cakes will be cut by the judge; all items in Section E & F may be tasted during judging
6. Entry forms and exhibits must be submitted to the organiser between 10.30 and 12.00 on the day of the show. Judging will commence at 12.00. Results will be announced at 13.00.
7. Entries cannot be accepted without a completed form and the correct fee
8. The Judges' decisions will be final
9. Exhibits must be removed between 4pm and 5pm on the day of the show
